Waycross is a conference center owned and operated by the Episcopal Diocese of Indianapolis. They host all sorts of events and summer camps. Some of the lodging is hotel-like, some is dorm-like, there are cabins and camping is available.

All lodging choices will include 3 meals per day. For a Friday night stay, the meals are Friday supper, Saturday breakfast and lunch. For a Saturday night stay, the meals are Saturday supper, Sunday breakfast and lunch.

If you are coming for the day, you can choose your meals. The cost for one meal is \$23, two meals is \$33 and three is \$45.

The cabins and the Main House are dorm-like. You can either bring your own linens, or purchase the linen packet for \$17.

Lodging at the Conference Center is more hotel-like and does include linens.

Some of the rooms are on the second floor and there are no elevators, so please indicate if you prefer a first floor room.
